Size, type, & construction of building, as well as, accessibility and site conditions are determining factors in shed moving prices. Typically, a shed will need skids or runners underneath the floor system to be moved in the yard.

GENERAL PRICING INFORMATION

- Above pricing includes 3 ½ hours of relocating the shed, as well as unblocking, then blocking and leveling of building using existing blocks for shed to be moved. If extra blocks are needed because new shed location is not as level as old location, \$4.00 per additional block will be charged, or customer can have additional blocks on hand (which is preferred.)
- Add 4x4 skids in order for shed to be moved, if needed \$60.00 fee (\$85 for larger building) + material cost (pressure-treated 4x4). The newly attached skids will remain on the shed, and we will level the shed using cement blocks, which makes for a stronger and more secure foundation set.
- Removal of ramps or steps \$25.00 (We do not reattach ramps unless contracted in writing.)
- If hourly charges pass 3 ½ hours, contracted price is \$65.00 per hour. This hourly rate covers the labor rate and use of truck and equipment.
- Unfortunately, there will be a \$125.00 charge if the customer fails to have shed or site ready on day of shed move.

CUSTOMER TO DO CHECKLIST DAY OF

- **E-MAIL PICTURE OF SHED**, measurements of shed (refer to shed measurement sheet) and directions for "move from" and "move to" locations to cardinalbuildings@gmail.com.
- Empty the contents of the shed.
- Remove ALL dog waste from working area(s)
- Sign waiver. Shed Moves are at Owner's Risk due to the nature of moving buildings.
- Remove fence posts or gates if needed to allow access of equipment or shed.
- Remove low hanging tree limbs and overgrown plant growth and debris around shed at both locations to allow access to the shed.
- Locate sprinklers, septic tanks, etc. Point out/mark any areas of concern that you do not want driver or equipment to drive over.
- Have payment on hand the day of shed move. (Cash/Check). Payment due at time of shed move.
- Check with local City and HOA to make sure that you have approval for where you are placing the shed.
